This requires a systematic, measured, and continuous improvement strategy, acknowledging that sustainable procurement must be both meaningful and substantial.

Sustainable Procurement Policy Statement:

NOCIL Limited is committed to sustainability as a key element driving our actions to practice green chemistry. NOCIL limited is committed to safeguard the health, safety, society, well-being of stakeholders and the environment by minimizing adverse effects arising from our operations across the entire value chain. We are committed to Responsible Care® and the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) relevant to our business. As a part of our commitment to sustainability, we have initiated this policy to guide our procurement practices and ensure that we engage with suppliers who share our values.

Scope:

Key consideration for Supplier Selection:

We rely on our Suppliers to provide materials, products, and services in a consistently timely manner which are of the highest quality and meet all the specific contractual obligations and specifications set out in written agreements. We also expect our Suppliers to operate in a manner that is appropriate, in terms of ethical, legal, environmental, and social responsibilities. The approved supplier shall adhere the Company's evolving ESG Framework attached in the PO copy and Supplier code of conduct. We are committed to give preference to our partners who operates their business in a way that supports the NOCIL's commitment to the highest environmental, governance and ethical standards.

NOCIL will track supplier performance based on quality, delivery, Health and Safety, and ESG parameters and same will be communicated to suppliers. The minimum acceptable supplier performance rating score is 60%. In the event of performance rating score dropping below 60% during any period, NOCIL will collaborate with supplier to uplift and match the expectations without undertaking any financial liability on NOCIL. The company also reserves audit rights at the supplier locations as per its risk controls procedures.

We are committed to strengthen collaboration with suppliers to actively participate in sustainability initiatives. We would Work together to seamlessly identify and address areas for improvement and potential risks, ensuring sustainable growth and effective grievance resolution.

Our Sustainable Procurement Objectives:

- 1. NOCIL Limited will ensure full adherence to relevant internal and external stakeholder engagement on sustainable procurement.
- 2. NOCIL will ensure that its targeted suppliers have signed off on the NOCIL's Supplier code of conduct catering Raw material and Packaging Material.
- 3. NOCIL limited will conduct the sustainability assessment of their targeted suppliers.
- 4. NOCIL Limited will promote the procurement from MSME and other vulnerable groups like Women led or physically challenged people led business.
- 5. NOCIL limited will collaborate and train them to start capturing the Scope 1 and Scope 2 data of their targeted suppliers.

Governance:

We at NOCIL have established governance in sustainable procurement to make informed, responsible purchase decisions that balance economic, environmental, and social objectives. It ensures that procurement practices contribute to long-term sustainability goals while promoting ethical business practices and stakeholder trust.

It ensures that procurement decisions align with sustainability goals, legal compliance, and ethical standards.
